

Elkrun Township Board of Trustees
March 31, 2025

Chairman Perrino called to order the regular meeting of the Elkrun Township Board of Trustees meeting at 7:00 pm. The following trustees were in attendance:

Randy Perrino
Kurt Seachrist
Andy Sweeney

The minutes shall reflect 1 visitor (s) present. The previous meeting minutes from March 12, 2025 were accepted on a motion of Trustee Seachrist, Trustee Sweeney gave the second. All in favor with a roll call vote. Chairman Perrino recognized the visitor (s) and fiscal officer as the following business was discussed:

OLD BUSINESS

The township received the schedule from the Engineers office for Chip and Seal (July 9-15) and Reclaimer Program (June 24-30). Trustee Perrino reported he had talked to Rick McCullough Excavating who is scheduled to clean out the swamp area on Greenwood Rd for Mr. & Mrs. Dixon. The pipe put in by the township several years ago is higher than needed. It was decided that while Mr. McCullough is there and prior to Chip and Seal the pipe will be drained and a lower pipe will be put in its place. Mr. McCullough will shoot for depth and report back to the township.

Trustee Sweeney reported that the Northern side of the township has been measured for the spraying that was discussed earlier for weeds. Before measuring the south side Trustee Sweeney wanted to make sure hiring out was still the route everyone wanted to go. Center Township has certified an employee who can do their spraying, we could consider riding with them for ours. After some discussion if the township wanted the liability of having someone certified for weed killer Trustee Seachrist said he would rather hire the weed spraying out, Trustee Sweeney and Perrino agreed.

The discussion about hiring a third full time employee is still being reviewed. It was reported that when Lisbon changed their health insurance instead of 100% premium coverage for employee and family an employee hired after January 2024 would be covered 100% with family coverage being covered only at 25%. Health insurance is one of the biggest costs of employees, so the township is looking for options.

NEW BUSINESS

The following correspondence was received by standard mail and email, presented for review than retained for filing as required:

The township received notice of the 2025 line striping program. Trustee Seachrist made the motion to stripe the end of Elkton West Point as done every year and Fairfield School Rd between SR 154 and SR 517 using the polyester centerline paint, Trustee Perrino gave the second. The motion passed with all ayes.

The township received two quotes for concrete work, the first is a 10x30 pad 10 inches thick in the front of the garage and continuing around the building a 16x42 parking lot extension 6 inches thick at a cost of \$8,462.00. The other is 20x25 concrete pad at the cemetery with wire mesh reinforcement at a cost of \$4,6500.00. The township will prepare around the garage and A&A Construction will prepare the cemetery. Trustee Sweeney made the motion to approve the quotes as submitted by A&A Construction at a total cost of \$13,112.00, Trustee Seachrist gave the second. The motion passed with all ayes.

The township received quotes to insulate the garage, these will be tabled until later. The bathroom will be painted in the garage. Ganders Flat Rd has not slipped anymore however there was discussion on having some concrete dumped to hold it in place. Trustee Seachrist ask Mr. Anderson to put a No Engine brake sign on Pine Hollow Rd near Riffle, he had a resident request for the sign.

The following financial reports were submitted for review: the most current March month end, appropriation and revenue status, payment register, fund status, month end fund summary, receipt report, payment listing payment warrants with the relevant invoices attached and orders. Ms. Wonner reported the first half real estate settlement has been received and posted as of March 28th. Other reports and items were reviewed, signed, and approved as Trustee Seachrist made the motion to pay the bills and Trustee Sweeney gave the second. The motion passed with all ayes.

There being no further business to discuss, Trustee Perrino made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 pm. Trustee Seachrist gave the second.
