

Elkrun Township Board of Trustees
December 29, 2025

Chairman Perrino called to order the regular meeting of the Elkrun Township Board of Trustees meeting at 7:00 pm. The following trustees were in attendance:

The minutes shall reflect 0 visitor (s) present. The previous meeting minutes from December 10, 2025 were accepted on a motion of Trustee Sweeney, Trustee Seachrist gave the second. All in favor with a roll call vote. Chairman Perrino recognized the visitor (s) and fiscal officer as the following business was discussed:

OLD BUSINESS

The township received the 2025 Township Highway System Mileage Certification from the County Engineer's office. All trustees signed the required forms they will be sent back to the engineer's office.

Road Foreman Anderson reported the new garage doors are scheduled to be installed in the morning. The trustees and Mr. Anderson discussed insulation of the ceiling in the garage, to use insulation boards and do in house it was estimated to be under \$1,500.00. After some more discussion it was decided to obtain a quote on spray insulation which has a longer life expectancy and does a better job. Mr. Anderson also reported that when talking to a neighboring township he was told that the cost to pave roads with R&R Paving was less expensive than the chip and seal cost, it was decided to at least get quotes from R&R in 2026. Mr. Anderson asked about the insurance cost on the old dump truck sitting outside, the cost is minimal. If anything were to happen while still owned by the township it would be covered.

NEW BUSINESS

The following correspondence was received by standard mail and email, presented for review than retained for filing as required:

1. Ohio Township Association Notices

The township received an application from Pin Oak to install a driveway at the Westover well sight on Pine Hollow Rd, Road Foreman Anderson will receive the area and plans. The trustees approved the application based on Mr. Anderson's approval. Fiscal Officer Wonner was asked by the trustees to remind Pin Oak of bonding requirements for the use of the road.

The township received notice from OMEGA on the availability of grants for township roads that are used by oil and gas companies, each project is eligible for up to \$500,000.00. Trustee Perrino will speak to Engineer Heschel at the County Engineer's office as directed in the information for application processes. T

The following financial reports were submitted for review: all current month end reports, payment listing and payment warrants with the relevant invoices attached and purchase orders and most current fund summary. Other reports and items were reviewed, signed, and approved as Trustee Seachrist made the motion to pay the bills and Trustee Perrino gave the second. The motion passed with all ayes.
