George Kosko was present he stated there has not been any updated news regarding extending water lines to Elkton during the BWC meetings.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

There has not been anything received on the bond needed from the company on Elkton West Point Rd, Ms. Wonner stated since it is being mailed back and forth from the company to the insurance broker than to the township. The township does have the unsigned copy for reference.

Trustee Seachrist said he had met with Fire Chief Hall regarding the dry hydrant on Fairfield School Rd at the Neville Dairy Farm, Chief Hall feels this is a good thing and should be looked into. The pipe at Ray Lewis and Company would cost approximately \$1,200.00 with a total cost of no more than \$2,500.00. He has spoke with Neville they are ok with where it would be located and a possible pull off for the firetrucks. Jake Anderson, road department supervisor, will meet with Gary Dailey.

Fiscal Officer Wonner reported the township is not receiving royalties for the Friends Cemetery to date that would cover any major up keep.

The cleanup date for the township has been scheduled for May 11<sup>th</sup>.

The township has received a couple letters interest for the position in the road department, this was tabled until a later meeting. Mr. Anderson reported that Mr. Strobel is to be back to work Monday March 4<sup>th</sup>.
