

Elkrun Township Board of Trustees
August 13, 2025

Chairman Perrino called to order the regular meeting of the Elkrun Township Board of Trustees meeting at 7:00 pm. The following trustees were in attendance:

Kurt Seachrist
Andy Sweeney

The minutes shall reflect 3 visitor (s) present. The previous meeting minutes from July 23, 2025 were accepted on a motion of Trustee Sweeney, Trustee Seachrist gave the second. All in favor with a roll call vote. Chairman Perrino recognized the visitor (s) and fiscal officer as the following business was discussed:

OLD BUSINESS

Trustee Perrino reported he spoke with Troy Graft at the County Engineer's office regarding the water line project. Mr. Graft reported there is not a tap in fee for sewer, residents would be responsible for the entire cost of the line installation from the main line to the resident. Average cost for the water taps in that is optional to the residents is \$3,250.00. The trustees discussed offering a flat amount to all residents with the American Rescue Plan money that has been set aside for this, when the project is at the point of install and a cost is known the trustees will make a decision on how to proceed. The trustees also discussed offering to make a contribution to the install of the fire hydrants using fire levy money, a decision will be made on this after talking to the Engineers office.

Asst. County Prosecutor Hartup responded to the question about the township placing speed bumps on Leslie Rd by a resident. The township is able to install in his opinion. Trustee Seachrist made the motion to purchase speed bumps and signage at a cost not to exceed \$1,200.00, Trustee Sweeney gave the second. The motion passed with all ayes. There was also discussion about the same resident parking on the road to block traffic, the road department was told if this happens to call the sheriff.

Trustee Perrino made the motion to approve and easement for work to be completed on township right of way for the water line install project, Trustee Seachrist gave the second. The motion passed with all ayes. Trustee Perrino will return the completed easement to the county.

NEW BUSINESS

The following correspondence was received by standard mail and email, presented for review than retained for filing as required:

1. Ohio Township Association Notice

Trustee Seachrist reported that Ohio Edison will be installing new poles on Davner Rd, at this time there is no indication the poles will be installed outside of any right of ways. Ohio Edison has been asked to keep the poles back as far as possible in the right way, the road needs to be widened this would make it easier.

Road foreman Anderson reported that the gutter on the East side of the building has been overflowing because of the trees on that side. Contractor Jerry Young will be called to put gutter guards on all the gutters.

The trustees reviewed resume's and still looking to add another full-time employee with the resignation of Dave Holland.

Cody Wolfgang who lives on Churchill Rd has requested a new stop sign be installed at the bottom of the hill coming off of Darner Rd, the current sign is very hard to see. Road Foreman Anderson will place a second sign.

The following financial reports were submitted for review: July bank reconciliation and all month end reports, payment listing and payment warrants with the relevant invoices attached and purchase orders and most current fund summary. Other reports and items were reviewed, signed, and approved as Trustee Sweeney made the motion to pay the bills and Trustee Seachrist gave the second. The motion passed with all ayes.

There being no further business to discuss, Trustee Seachrist made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 pm. Trustee Sweeney gave the second.
