Elkrun Township Board of Trustees
January 10, 2024

Chairman Sweeney called to order the regular meeting of the Elkrun Township Board of Trustees meeting at 7:02 pm. The following trustees were in attendance:

The minutes shall reflect 4 visitor (s) present. The previous meeting minutes of December 27, 2023 were accepted on motion of Trustee Perrino, Trustee Sweeney gave the second. Chairman Sweeney recognized the visitor (s) and fiscal officer as the following business was discussed:

Danielle Birch, who is running for County Commissioner was present to introduce herself and to get to know the other elected officials in the county. George Kosko was present at the meeting, he introduced himself as the BWD liaison to the township, he has served in the position for 8 to 10 years. Trustee Perrino ask if there were any updates on the request from the resident on Stookesberry for water? To get water to the address it would need to come from SR 30/45 across private property. The resident who is requesting will need to obtain an easement and put in the pipe if he wants to connect to the line, this is approximately 1600 feet. BWD is currently working on water to Wellsville, this led to comments on the project for water to Elkton. During the last meeting it was mentioned the project was to bid last fall but was pushed back. Ms. Birch ask about this project, she was given the background on how the township has been trying to get water to Elkton for at least 6 years.

Wayne Chamberlain West Point Fire Chief was present, he distributed the 2023 fire run report speaking also about the EMS runs. He also had the 2024 fire contract; the trustees had no changes or concerns with the contract. Trustee Seachrist made the motion to approve the 2024 contract, Trustee Sweeney gave the second.

Deb Bins was present with concerns about someone driving through the grassy areas in the Elkton West Point Rd and Fairmont Rd intersection, including the park where the pavilion is located. The trustees agreed this is an issue, the road department will assess before putting guard rail post there to block the area from traffic.

OLD BUSINESS

There has not been anything received on the bond needed from the company on Elkton West Point Rd, Ms. Wonner stated since it is being mailed back and forth from the company to the insurance broker than to the township if not received in a few weeks she will contact the insurance company for an update. The township does have the unsigned copy for reference.

NEW BUSINESS

The following correspondence was received by standard mail and email, presented for review than retained for filing as required:

1. Ohio Township Association Notices

The township received a request for a letter of support from Comcast for the Ohio Residential Broadband Expansion Grant they are applying for, Trustee Perrino made the motion to send the letter as requested. Trustee Sweeney gave the second.

Trustee Perrino made the motion to accept the ODOT 2023 township highway system mileage certification of 51.079 miles, Trustee Seachrist gave the second.

Trustee Perrino made the motion to approve Resolution No. 0102024, the designee for Certified Public Records training, Trustee Seachrist gave the second.

Road foreman Jake Anderson mentioned the department has the broken signs for the cemetery on Cream Ridge Rd, someone had hit them earlier in the month. The tourism board will be contacted.

The following financial reports were submitted for review: December bank reconciliation, December month end reports, payment listing payment warrants with the relevant invoices attached and orders. All year end 2023 reports were available for review. Other reports and items were reviewed, signed, and approved as Trustee Seachrist made the motion to pay the bills and Trustee Perrino gave the second.

There being no further business to discuss, Trustee Sweeney made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:27 pm, Trustee Seachrist gave the second.
